Under the Department's contract with SecureFuture, ASCF is required to report on outcomes rather than performance relating to the delivery of ITL programmes. ASCF is therefore not included in the ITL table. Under the contract, ASCF will begin to be measured on reducing reoffending outcomes from 1 July 2017 and the results for the 2017/18 financial year will be compared to the Department's results. The results will be available after the end of 2017/18, once the full year's result is known.
