### Corrections' Long Term Network Configuration Plan

On 15 October 2024, the Cabinet Expenditure and Regulatory Review Committee:

- 1        **noted** that the Minister of Corrections seeks Cabinet support in progressing the Long Term Network Configuration Plan (LTNCP), an overarching plan to deliver a safer, better quality, cohesive prison network, 9(2)(f)(iv) over a 20-year timeframe;
- 2        **agreed** that the LTNCP will inform all future significant capital investment in the prison network;
- 3        **agreed** that support of the LTNCP does not indicate support or subsequent agreement to Budget funding;
- 4        9(2)(f)(iv)
- 5        **noted** that in line with the LTNCP, the first two investments into Strategic Nodes being progressed are the Waikeria Prison expansion and Christchurch Men's Prison Redevelopment Programme;
- 6        9(2)(f)(iv)
- 7        **noted** that the support of the LTNCP does not have any immediate financial implications, 9(2)(f)(iv)
- 8        **directed** Corrections to report back to the Ministers of Corrections, Finance and Infrastructure on the opportunities associated with committing to a significant programme of work, 9(2)(f)(iv)
